

1. “Even if”, “even though”

- [1] Ashita tenki ga warukute **mo**, doraibu ni ikikmashō  
*Even if the weather is bad tomorrow, let's go for a drive.*
- [2] Tomodachi ga tsukutte kureta no de, amari oishiku nakute **mo** ryōri wa zenbu tabemashita yo.  
*Since a friend made food for me, I ate everything, even though it didn't taste very good.*

2. After verbs, used in conjunction with interrogatives for emphasis”: “no matter where (who, what, etc)”

- [3] Takeda-san wa, ikura nonde **mo** yowanai desu yo.  
*No matter how much Takeda drinks, he doesn't get drunk.*
- [4] o hanami no toki wa, doko e itte **mo** hito de ippai da.  
*During flower-viewing time, there are crowds of people wherever you go.*

3. Emphasizes an approximate limit “at the most”:

- [5] sono kamera nara, takakute **mo** go-man-en kurai deshō.  
*At most, that camera will cost around 50,000 yen.*
- [6] Ano shibai wa nagakute **mo** san-jikan de owarimasu yo.  
*That play will last three hours at most.*

<b>Nouns:</b>	tenki doraibu ryōri zenbu hanami toki hito kamera (ka-me-ra) shibai jikan	weather drive, trip by car meal all flower viewing time, hour, moment person camera play, drama time, hour
<b>Pronouns:</b>	doko sono	where, what place that
<b>Adjectives:</b>	warui oishi ippai (na adj) takai nagai	bad delicious full, filled (with), crowded tall, cost long (distance of time)
<b>Particle:</b>	kurai	about
<b>Auxiliary:</b>	nara	as for; on the topic of
<b>Adverb:</b>	amari ikura	(not) very, (not) much / too much how much
<b>Verbs:</b>	yoinasu, you, yotte imasu kuremasu, kureru, kurete imasu owarimasu, owaru, owatte imasu	to get drunk to give / giver not speaker to end
<b>Expressions:</b>	deshō	it seems; I think; I guess; I wonder
